# What is Title I?



- **Purpose:** to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach minimum proficiency.
- **Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA):** requires the state and district to review annually the academic progress of federally funded Title I schools and to identify schools in need of improvement.

- High quality professional development for school staff
